Motorcycle Rider Education Basic Rider Course

- Fulfills mandatory requirement of motorcycle driver education for those under 18
- For anyone 14 or older, possessing a driver's permit, and currently enrolled in or have successfully completed a driver's education course
- For ANY rider who wishes to ride safely and correctly. No experience is necessary. Beginners are Welcome!

Enrollment

Class enrollment is limited to twelve students for the classroom portion and six students for the range portion. Students receive a certificate issued by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation and Northeast Iowa Community College upon successful completion of the entire program. The certificate is necessary for application of a Iowa Motorcycle Operator's License. There is a \$6 charge if a duplicate certificate must be issued.

To successfully complete the course a student must:

- Attend all elements of classroom and range time
- Successfully pass motorcycle range skill test
- Pay tuition in advance of the first session

Course Content

The five hours of classroom experience includes Iowa law, introduction to motorcycling, preparing to ride, and street strategies.

The ten hours of range driving includes familiarization with a motorcycle, straight line riding, turning, shifting, braking, quick stops, avoiding hazards, swerving and cornering.

Equipment

Northeast Iowa Community College, in cooperation with Waukon Power Sports, will furnish motorcycles, helmets and supplies for the Basic Rider Course.

Students will receive a letter with information verifying class dates, times and location, one to two weeks prior to class. Information will also include forms to be completed and what to bring to class

- Signed parental permission (those under 18) or signed release form
- Valid driver's license or
- Valid driver's permit and verification of driver's education class

All students must bring to range sessions:

- License or permit
- Gloves, over-the-ankle leather footwear, long pants (no shorts), and a long sleeve shirt or jacket
